PERSONS WITH DISABILITY DISBURSEMENT REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2024

Introduction

Persons with disability activities are funded from their 3% share of the District Assembly's Common Fund. The Disability Fund Management Committee manages the DACF for PWDs and it has a membership of five (5).

This report presents the information on the disbursement of persons with disability's share of the District Assemblies' Common Fund for Banda District. The disbursement covers activities such as; scholarship to brilliant but needy PWD student, support to PWDs in school, and setting up PWDs in income generating activities of their choice, medical support, provision of mobility items to PWDs, and capacity building of the Ghana Federation of Disabled.

There are 352 registered PWDs in Banda District. Out of this number, 240 have been set up with relief items and 112 yet to be given relief items.

Objective

To minimise poverty among PWDs particularly those outside the formal sector of employment and enhancement of their social image through dignified labour, by supporting individual persons with disability in income generating activities as a means of economic empowerment, supporting children, students and trainees with educational support, building the capacity of various Association and organisation with persons with disability, and support persons with disabilities to have access to technical aids and other assistive devices and equipment.

Beneficiaries

Full academic fees and stipends was paid to three (3) PWDs who are students in tertiary institutions in the country, Kofi Boamah (University for Development Studies – Wenchi Distant Learning Centre), Victoria Kuuvadare (Al-Faruq College of Education – Wenchi), and Samuel Sonyinador (College of Health – Kintampo). Thirty-Seven 37 PWDs were also set up in business during the year under review. These

beneficiaries were trained on enterprise development and business management. This was to equip them with the basic skills needed to manage the business they are venturing.

The table 2 below presents the detailed information on the beneficiaries made up of 16 males and 21 females.

Twelve (41) PWDs were identified and registered during the year under review. This is indicated in TABLE 1 below. Again, the 150 PWDs and the Executives of the Ghana Federation for the Disabled (GFD) in Banda were sensitized on the new guidelines for the disbursement and utilization of fund was undertaken during the year under review. Selected members of the District Federation for the Deaf were sponsored to fully take part in 3 days annual programme in Wenchi for all members in the region and this included polo shirts, feeding allowances, and transportation to Wenchi and back to Banda.
